




 More than 100 children had the opportunity to demonstrate their knowledge of foreign languages using the Akelius digital platform at school competitions in the Una-Sana Canton area that were organized in November.

The competitions were held in elementary schools "Harmani I" Elementary School, "Harmani II" Elementary School, Ostrožac Elementary School, "Stijena" Elementary School, "Gornje Prekounje - Ripač" Elementary School, and "Prekounje" Elementary School, where children demonstrated in groups their knowledge of the English language and the use of the Akelius digital platform for learning foreign languages, and the groups of children who had the most points at the end represented the school they came from in the final competition.

 The final competition, organized in Elementary School "Gornje Prekounje - Ripač" brought together 30 students from six elementary schools, their foreign language teachers, as well as children on the move.

Students had the opportunity to socialize and present their work to their peers. During the competition, they made models of their schools as well as wrote essays about schools in English.

As part of the competition, they used the Akelius digital application for learning foreign languages on tablets, on which they searched for the words needed for models of their schools.

At the end, all students received diplomas and gift packages for participating in the competition, but they also made new friends.

"The goal of the competition was to get to know each other, socialize and make friends. The children learned a lot of interesting things about other schools, as well as about children on the move, with whom some of the students had the opportunity to meet for the first time. Each of the teachers encouraged their students who demonstrated exceptional knowledge of the English language, which they achieved with the help of the Akelius digital platform for learning foreign languages," said the foreign language teacher during this competition.
