TIJUANA.- In order to meet the training needs of basic education students, the Secretariat of Education of Baja California, in coordination with the United Nations Children's Fund (UNICEF), delivered tablets for the implementation of the “Akelius” platform.

In this regard, the Secretary of Education of Baja California, Gerardo Arturo Solís Benavides, expressed the importance of supporting students with technological tools in their learning, as well as continuing with strategies to reinforce foreign languages.

Solís Benavides added that the “Akelius” platform is supported by the Radix Education Association, which seeks to improve learning processes and teaching methods.

He mentioned that on this occasion 26 tablets were delivered to basic education schools in the municipality of Tijuana at Esc. Sec. Gral. No. 4 Ricardo Flores Magón in the morning shift.

For her part, Yara Amparo López López, coordinator of the Binational Migrant Education Program, indicated that “we continue to support girls, boys and adolescents in a migratory situation so that they can continue their studies, preventing language from being an barrier”.
