Technology is undeniably an integral part of our daily lives, and education, as part of it, could not be included.

Technology in education is an approach that aims to activate the interest and desire for learning, while making the learning process easier in an interactive and fun way.

The Akelius self-learning platform, leveraging on new technologies in learning, enables, through a variety of activities, games and songs, each child to learn at his own pace one of the many foreign languages available, offering lessons for various language learning levels.

So, minors temporarily residing in the Prison Reception and Identification Center, taking advantage of the new technologies applied what they learned through the Akelius self-learning platform.

Through this platform, underage students practiced their Greek knowledge in numbers.

At first, each child, on their own tablet, repeated what they learned, and then teaching was taken to the big screen of our Center and learning took the form of a quiz game.

The result justified their effort, as through cooperation and interaction they managed to successfully complete the quiz, gaining confidence, knowledge, and of course beautiful experiences.

The All Children in Education Program is an initiative of ARSIS - Association for the Social Support of Youth co-financed by European Commission and implemented by several partners, including UNICEF Greece

The program deals with facilitating the inclusion of refugee children in Standard education through the provision of Non-Standard Education services and other supplementary activities, at the Centers for Study and Creative Employment in Athens, Thessaloniki, Kos (KEDU), Samos ("ALKI ZEE"), at the KI Prison in Evros, as well as Mobile Units in Leros and Crete.
