

UNICEF Bosna i Hercegovina

Since 2020, the Akelius Digital Language Learning Course has been used in reception centers in Bosnia and Herzegovina as an informal educational content for learning foreign languages.

As of 2020, over 3,500 children on the move had the opportunity to learn English and German through hybrid teaching methods.

The range of content provided by the Akelius Digital Course, both in terms of thematic units and levels and types of interaction, enable teachers to respond to the different individual needs of students, which is especially important when working with children on the move, who have different levels of previous education and language background.

UNICEF BiH supports the educational authorities in Sarajevo Canton and Una-Sana Canton in strengthening the digital competencies of teachers, hybrid teaching methods, and the use of the Akelius Digital Course.
